The Association's roots can be traced back to 1908 when it formed to provide a united voice for the province's hunters and anglers and direct their combined skills and abilities towards the fostering of common conservation goals. Ninety-eight years later, the Association is more than 14,000 strong with over 100 clubs distributed throughout Alberta.

The Alberta Fish & Game Association is involved in the maintenance, enhancement and securement of habitat as well as the protection and improvement of hunting and fishing for present and future Albertans. This is done through political action initiatives and advocacy programs; and the accomplishment of common goals and exchange of information, knowledge and expertise through membership in and liaison roles with local, provincial, national and international organizations. Some of the more publicly-recognized conservation programs founded by AFGA include: the Wildlife Trust Fund, Parkland Stewardship Program, Operation Grassland Community, Habitat Stewardship Program, Heritage Farmstead Program, and the Shed Antler & Hide Collection Program.
