Forests:

- enhance the social and economic benefits of our forests and forested lands;
- oversee forest industry development;
- monitor the export of forest products;
- administer forest revenues and new timber allocations; and
- support a full range of uses and values including timber production, wildlife habitat and recreation.

Fish and Wildlife:

- manage, conserve and allocate fish and wildlife resources;
- protect fish and wildlife through legislation, regulation and enforcement; and
- manage programs for anglers, hunters and trappers.
