

LAND OWNER & HUNTER RELATIONS HFTF PARTICIPATES AT TRADE SHOW

The Hunting For Tomorrow Foundation recently participated at the Farm and Ranch Trade Show from March 30 – April 2, 2005 in Edmonton. This was the first time the HFTF set up a booth and attended the show. The focus of the booth was on landowner/hunter relations.

The HFTF display included a sign, *“At the Hunting For Tomorrow Foundation, we recognize that access to both public and private land is essential. On behalf of all hunters, we extend our appreciation and heartfelt thanks to all landowners that allow hunters access to their property”.*

Landowner/Hunter Access survey forms were available and landowners were asked to provide their opinions on access for hunting, posting of land, Sunday hunting and compensation for access.

As well, the Landowner Hunter Access cards were available for distribution. These cards are designed to encourage more access for hunting, by providing the landowner with complete contact information about the hunter (name, address, phone number, WIN number, vehicle information, etc.). These cards were well received by both landowners and hunters.
