1. **Site:** EPCOR —Genesee Power Plant
2. **Location:** West of Edmonton — designated areas on EPCOR property (south of Highway 16 on Secondary Road 770)
3. **WMU:** 334
4. **Partners:** EPCOR
5. **Dates:** September 2010 to November 2010
6. **Equipment that may be used:** Bow and Arrow
7. **Species eligible to be hunted under this program:** Whitetail Deer, Mule Deer, Elk, Moose (draw only). See the Alberta Guide to Hunting Regulations for specific season dates and eligibility.

Important Notes

1. Whitetail deer, mule deer, elk, moose (draw only) and coyotes may be harvested on EPCOR property.
2. Animals should be field-dressed on the designated HFT property. Animals must be retrieved by foot access only (no vehicles are permitted on this property at any time). Keep in mind that the majority of the property that HFT is authorized to hunt on is under some form of lease agreement with a farmer (either for crop or pasture). Be aware that you may encounter these farmers; please be courteous and informative. If they have any questions or concerns, please get their name and phone number and Kelly Semple will follow up. In the event that special access is required to assist with retrieval, please notify Kelly Semple **AND** contact the Guard House at 780-969-8505.
3. Youth or first time adult participants are authorized to use a cross-bow on the property.
4. All participants/Mentors must display the approved HFT Outdoor Bound Parking Pass on their vehicle windshield.
5. Full details of mentorship program members intending to hunt Genesee lands (including vehicle details) will be kept in a master binder in the Genesee Main Gate Guardhouse. The guardhouse will make cross-references to the master participant list to verify program eligibility.
6. The assigned guard will **actively** patrol all Genesee lands continuously, both to show a security presence to participants and deter infiltration by non-members wishing to trespass or conduct hunting activities of their own outside of this program. (Including on non-dedicated lands). Please bear in mind EPCOR is not asking security to act as Fish & Wildlife enforcement officers but to support the Hunting For Tomorrow Program and existing enforcement activity (eyes and ears).
7. Patrolling should not interfere with the hunting process.
8. Hunting participants will be expected to park at field entrances.
